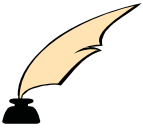

MEMORIAL DAY THOUGHTS FOR OUR VIETNAM ERA VETERANS

In case you haven't been paying attention these past few decades after you returned from Vietnam, the clock has been ticking.

The following are some statistics that are at once depressing yet in a larger sense should give you a **HUGE SENSE OF PRIDE**.

Of the 2,709,918 Americans who served in Vietnam, less than 850,000 are estimated to be alive today, with the youngest American Vietnam veteran's age approximated to be 60 years old.

So, if you're reading this, how does it feel to be among the last 1/3rd of all the U.S. veterans who served in Vietnam?

- Our peak troop strength in Vietnam was 543,482 (April 30, 1968).
- 61% of the men killed were 21 or younger.
- 11,465 of those killed were younger than **20** years old.
- Of those killed, **17,539** were married.
- Average age of men killed: **23.1** years
- Missing in Action: **2,338**
- POWs: **766** (**114** died in captivity).

As of January 15, 2014, there are **1,875** Americans still unaccounted for from the Vietnam War.
