A Message from our Deacon...

In the Gospel, Luke tells us that Jesus is walking through Jericho and He sees the tax collector Zacchaeus, up in a tree. Jesus tells him to "Make haste and come down for I must stay at your house today." It's not hard to understand that Zacchaeus is overwhelmed at this, as I suppose we all would be. In his joy Zacchaeus offers to make a substantial contribution to repay all those he has cheated. Jesus really isn't interested in either the gift or the amount of it as much as the change of heart it signifies. Jesus responds to the change of heart of Zacchaeus and declares to him that "today salvation has come to this house."

But, interestingly, Luke inserts one statement from the crowd at this point. "He has gone to be the guest of a sinner." Ahh, but who Zacchaeus once was.....he is not any longer. Hidden in this exchange is the Good News for Zacchaeus and for each of us....and for all with whom you may share it....

For every Saint there has been a past....and
For every Sinner.....there is a future.

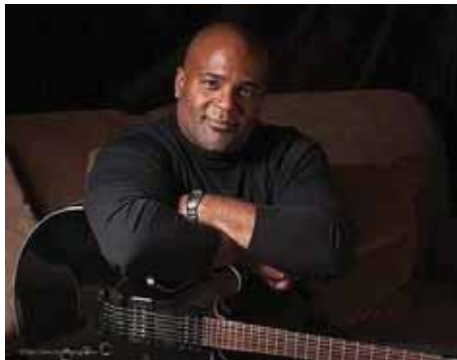

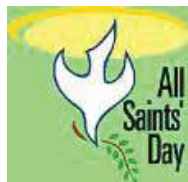

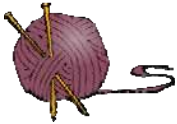
